

**Proceedings of the meeting of the University Internal Quality Assurance Cell,

2. To discuss the strategies for the NAAC second cycle of accreditation



Mr. Avijit Ghosh appreciated the efforts taken by the University to maintain the Campus and further proposed to make it Eco friendly and Sustainable campus.





With no other points from the members, the meeting concluded with the permission of the Chair.
