



Report National Seminar on “Environment: Indian perspective & current scenario”

Objective:

1. To create awareness among participants regarding increasing pollution and environmental degradation.
2. To raise awareness on the problems such as air pollution, plastic pollution, illegal wildlife trade and sustainable consumption.

Under the joint aegis of Jharkhand Rai University, Sarla Birla University, Jharkhand Technological University and Shiksha Utthan Nyas a National seminar was organized on **05 June 2021** on the occasion of World Environment Day.

The event was conducted through Cisco Webex & it was coordinated by Dr. Kavita Parmar (Environmental Head) Education Culture Trust Jharkhand, Program Invigilator Prof. Gopal Ji Sahai (State President) Shiksha Sanskriti Nyas and State Coordinator Shiksha Sanskriti Nyas Amar Kant Jha played an important role in the successful operation.

Speaking on the occasion Prof. (Dr.) Savita Sengar, Vice Chancellor, Jharkhand Rai University said “only one earth” – this was the first slogan of the first world Environment Day celebrated in 1974. Since then, we have seen many developments and changes around the world regarding the problems faced by our environment. Air pollution, Plastic pollution, illegal wildlife trade, sustainable consumption, sea level rise, food security, and many others issues need our immediate attention.

This year (2021) the theme of World Environment Day is Ecosystem Restoration. Ecosystem restoration can take many forms: growing trees, greening up cities, remodeling gardens, changing diets, or cleaning rivers and banks, etc. However, as humanity creates new developments and disruptions in terms of technology and innovations, we often make our progress by ignoring our responsibility to live in harmony with nature. This reminds me of a verse from the Rigveda, which says – “Thousands and hundreds of years if you want to enjoy the fruits and happiness of life, plant trees”.

There is a message in these verses that asks us to avoid exploiting nature and the environment. It asks us to do continuous afforestation to survive otherwise the ecological balance of the earth will be in danger: Said Atul Bhai Kothari, National Secretary Education Culture Trust, Delhi.

Chief Guest Prof. Pradeep Kumar Mishra, Vice Chancellor Jharkhand Technological University said: It is heartening to learn that countries are pledging to restore 350 million hectares of the world's deforestation and degraded land by 2030. This effort will prevent the degradation of ecosystems and restore them to achieve the global goals of restoring

natural diversity. Only with a healthy ecosystem can we increase people's livelihoods, combat climate change and prevent biodiversity loss.

Intellectuals, social workers, teachers, students from all over the state participated in the program.
