At the outset, the chairman welcomed the members of BOS. The following deliberations were made as per the items of the circulated agenda:

1. To remove one 3 credit course “PROFESSIONAL PRACTICES LAWS & ETHIC” of B.Tech Semester IV and transfer its 3 credit to course DISASTER MANAGEMENT of semester IV presently a non-credit subject from Intake 2021.

The members approved that the course “PROFESSIONAL PRACTICES LAWS & ETHIC” for B.Tech students of semester IV can be removed from curriculum & all mining related important topics in PROFESSIONAL PRACTICES LAWS & ETHIC may be added in the syllabus of mine management & other related subjects of the other semester.

2. To offer & approve one course “Soft Skills” from SWAYAM portal in place of “Professional Skills” for B.Tech students of Vth semester.

The members approved the course “Professional Skills” for B.Tech Vth Semester to be offered to students from SWAYAM portal and earn the credit.



3. **To remove two non-credit courses “Life Skills I” & “Life Skills II” of semester III & Semester IV respectively for Diploma course from Intake of 2021.**

The members approved the removal of the two non-credit courses for lateral students. Also, Revision of the Diploma Syllabus was suggested by the members.

4. **The proposal to include the subject “Community Engagement & Social Responsibility” in the curriculum of B.Tech program of semester III.**

The members approved the introduction of subject and also suggested Practical exam of 50 marks of written and practical exam for 50 marks to be taken out of the subject **Community Engagement & Social Responsibility** for students to be more effectively grasping the subject.

The meeting concluded with vote of thanks by the Chair to all members present.
